

## **About Our Citations**

The Portal offers a system-generated citation for each item. The Portal's citation format was influenced by the humanities style of *The Chicago Manual of Style* and by *Evidence Explained* by Elizabeth Shown Mills. Because the Portal is both a digital library and a preservation archive, three levels of identification are included in citations:

- 1. Identification of the original item, its creator, the original format, and the original creation date.
- 2. Identification of the item's electronic format, its digital location (permalink), the date the item was accessed, and the digital archives's name and location (URL).
- 3. Identification of the location of the original document.
