Dr. Albrecht opened the discussion and informed the Board of Regents that the Legislature exempted Community Colleges in this past session from the lowered tax rate cap, however, that could all change with next session. Chairman Pyburn talked about concerns of the uncertainty of the next Legislative session,

how it could adversely affect the college and that the opportunity to take care of the future of the college is now. There was discussion around adopting the roll back rate as the preferred tax rate for 2019-2020. The tax rate will go before the Board of Regents for a vote at the August 15, 2019 Board meeting. The scheduled dates for public tax hearings would be September 5 and 12th.
