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AGENCY MISSION

Alvin Community College exists to improve the lives of its constituents by providing affordable, accessible, high-quality and innovative academic, technical and cultural educational opportunities for the diverse communities that it serves.

Alvin Community College respectfully supports the \$1.9 billion formula funding request submitted by the Texas Association of Community Colleges (TACC) in its letter dated, July 24, 2018. With additional support from the State of Texas, Alvin Community College will make the following investments:

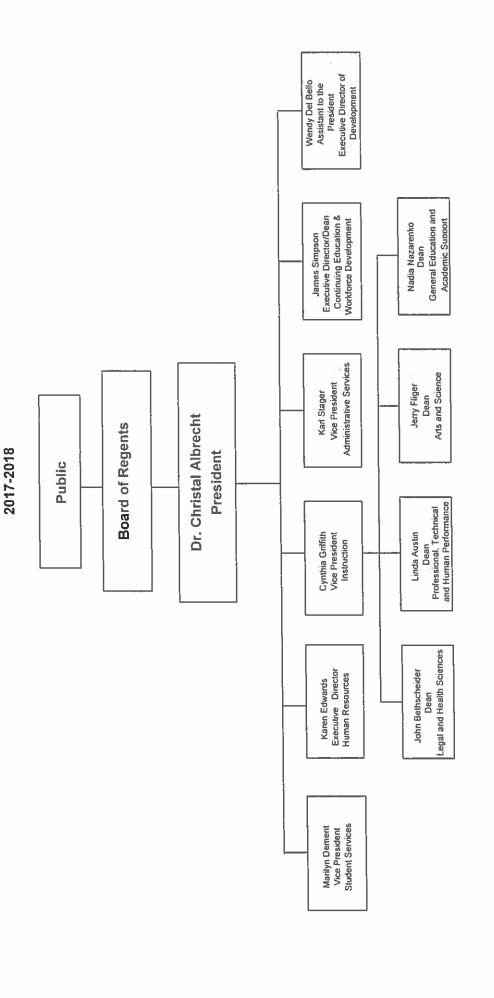
- ✓ Continue to expand dual credit offerings, particularly technical dual credit with the High School Career and Technical Education Departments, including Alvin Independent School District's new Career and Technical Education Center, which will lead to greater employment opportunities for graduates
- ✓ Align curricula between our High Schools' technical programs and the College's programs. While progress has been made in areas such as culinary arts, pharmacy technician, and emergency medical technician, other programs such as criminal justice, industrial technology, computer science, and paralegal studies require alignment.
- ✓ Fully implement the co-requisite model for mathematics and English
- ✓ With "meta majors" and Guided Pathways now designed and aligned with HB Endorsements, each program requires full alignment to the pathways in order to provide students with seamless career pathways

Alvin Community College has already heavily invested in the dual credit programs with our area high schools, with 158 high school students completing a two-year degree in May 2018, the same month as receiving their high school diploma. We provide a dual credit counselor at each high school to assist in the smooth transition from high school to college. We have expanded in this area to offer more dual credit for our technical program areas, including offering dual enrollment programs in the evening, which requires additional staffing. This will necessitate the further alignment of the high school technical curricula with the college curricula as described above. We have initiated a pilot of the co-requisite model and had great success in both math and English, with nearly 90% completion of the college level courses. Finally, the College is excited about the progress made with developing Guided Pathways and "meta-majors" to increase student completion of credentials in a more timely fashion. The next step is full alignment of all degree programs to the Guided Pathways and "meta-majors". All of these efforts will assist us in meeting the goals set forth in the 60X30TX Higher Education Strategic Plan.

Background checks are conducted on all security-sensitive positions as permitted by the Texas Government Code, Sec. 411.094 and Texas Education Code, Section 61.003 (8), and consistent with Alvin Community College's human resources policies and procedures.
