	Submit official transcripts from ALL previously attended colleges to the ACC Registrar (electronic preferred). Have your <a href="Health Pathways Advisor">Health Pathways Advisor</a> review out-of-state courses or any courses that are not direct equivalents to the prerequisite courses. <b>Deadline for review is August 15</b>
	for the September application cycle or February 15 for
	the March application cycle. Foreign transcripts must be
	accompanied by an official evaluation from an approved
	agency. Meet Texas Success Initiative (TSI) standards
	Attend an Applicant Meeting

	Hepatitis-B: submit proof of the first two Hep B
	immunizations or the first "heplisav" immunization, or
	submit copy of Hep B surface antibody titer report

	Take the HESI-A2 exam within 5 years of nursing
	application deadline. Minimum scores: 78 on reading
	section, 78 for cumulative score. Order HESI transcript to
