Program Description

The Alvin Community College Associate Degree Nursing (ADN) program is approved by the Texas Board of Nursing to provide an educational program for individuals who are interested in a career as a registered nurse (RN). Upon the successful completion of program requirements the graduate is qualified to make application to write the National Council Licensure Exam for Registered Nurses (NCLEX-RN). Alvin Community College ADN graduates consistently perform above state and national averages on the RN licensure exam. As reported by the BON, the Alvin Community College ADN pass rates for first time testers are: Year 2010 - 96.2%, Year 2009 - 98%, Year 2008 - 92%, Year 2007 - 98%, Year 2006 - 100%, Year 2005 - 96.55%

- A new nursing class begins each August And September and applications are accepted from January thru March and September thru October
- The program is accredited by the National League for Nursing Accrediting Commission (NLNAC).
- The program receives commendations from the BON for our graduates' excellent pass rates on the RN licensure exam.
- ACC/ADN graduates typically start their careers earning \$50,000.
- Clinical affiliations are with community hospitals as well as with hospitals in the world famous Texas Medical Center in Houston.
