Getting Started with MyBlackboard

Every MyBlackboard course is unique. For example, your instructor may be using MyBlackboard to supplement a course taught in a regular classroom environment and may only add a couple of key tools to MyBlackboard. Alternatively, your course may be taught entirely online and a variety of tools and content may be added to your MyBlackboard course.

Logging into MyBlackboard

1. First, go to the Alvin College Homepage at <http://www.alvincollege.edu>
2. Find the [MyBlackboard](#) link on the left side of the page.
3. You may also want to bookmark the direct link <http://bb6.alvincollege.edu> in case the ACC web page is down for some reason.
4. Enter your username and password.

HINT: Your user name is the same as your WebACcess username Your initial password is college

5. The first time you log in you will need to change your password. Remember that your old password is college. Your new password must have a minimum of 6 characters.
6. Once you submit your new password you will be taken back to the log in screen. You will need to log in with your username and new password that you just chose.

Getting Your Computer Ready

One of the easiest way to make sure that your computer is configured to work with MyBlackboard is to use the [Check Browser](#) button located at the top right of the Log in screen. It will run a check on your computer system and let you know if there are any conflicts.

If you have any problems with MyBlackboard, you will need to know who to contact for help.
