



University Transfer Information Alvin Community College and Midwestern State University

Degrees included in Agreement:

- 1. Bachelor of Science in Respiratory Care (B.S.R.C.)
- 2. Bachelor of Science in Nursing (B.S.N.)

GPA Requirements for Program:

All transfer courses require a grade of C or higher.

Requirements to Apply:

- Associate of Applied Science (A.A.S.) Degree in Respiratory Care.
- Applicants must meet Midwestern State University <u>admission requirements</u> and are required to finalize an official degree plan as directed by their Midwestern State University Program Advisor prior to completion of the second semester of study at Midwestern State University.

ACC Credit Hour Transfer Information:

- Midwestern State University will accept the entire lower division program of study of a student who receives an Associate of Applied Science (A.A.S.) Degree in Respiratory Care at ACC.
- Every lower division ACC course within the Coordinating Board Academic Course Guide Manual will be transferable to Midwestern State University.
- 36 of the 42 required general core credits must be completed prior to being formally admitted into the program.
- The total number of transfer hours to be applied to a degree plan will be capped at 60 credit hours for academic Associate Degree programs unless the applicant obtains written permission from Midwestern State University prior to transfer.
- 41 semester credit hours of general education requirements of the ACC core curriculum will be accepted toward the Baccalaureate Degree at Midwestern State University, even if the applicant has not completed an Associate of Arts (A.A.) or Associate of Science (A.S.) Degree.
- The basic core American Government will need to be taken online at MSU (or another Texas approved institution) because it includes Texas Government.

Note:

• Enrollment in at least one RRT-BSRC course is guaranteed for new students who graduate from ACC and are accepted to MSU during the regular registration time period.

Degree 2:

Bachelor of Science in Nursing (B.S.N.)

GPA Requirements for Program:

- 3.0 cumulative GPA on a 4.0 scale for all nursing prerequisite courses.
- All transfer science courses require a grade of C or higher.

Requirements to Apply:

- Associate of Applied Science Degree in Nursing (A.A.S./A.D.N.)
- Meet all Midwestern State University <u>admission requirements</u> and finalize an official degree plan as directed by their Midwestern State University Program Advisor prior to completion of the second semester of study at Midwestern State University.
- Meet all Midwestern State University Wilson School of Nursing admission requirements.
- Current, unrestricted license to practice as a Registered Nurse (R.N.) in the U.S.

ACC Credit Hours Required Before Transfer:

60 semester credit hours.
