Degree:

Bachelor of Science in Nursing (B.S.N.)

GPA Requirements for Program:

- 3.0 cumulative GPA on a 4.0 scale for all nursing prerequisite courses.
- All transfer science courses require a grade of C or higher.

Requirements to Apply:

- Associate of Applied Science Degree in Nursing (A.A.S./A.D.N.)
- Meet all Texas A&M University – Corpus Christi [admission requirements](#).
- Meet all Texas A&M University – Corpus Christi College of Nursing & Health Sciences [admission requirements](#).
- Current, unrestricted license to practice as a Registered Nurse (R.N.) in the U.S.

ACC Credit Hours Required Before Transfer:

90 credit hours (including a Core Curriculum Program, prerequisites, and at least 30 hours of Nursing Validation/Articulation).

Note – Program Information:

- Students should consult their Texas A&M University – Corpus Christi Academic Advisor for additional information on core curriculum and support courses, including the sequence in which the courses should be taken. Science courses may not be older than seven (7) years for transferring B.S.N. students.
- A minimum of 30 prescribed upper-division credit hours (as listed in the academic catalog) must be satisfactorily completed at Texas A&M University – Corpus Christi.
