



Transfer Pathway Agreement Alvin Community College and Texas A&M University – Kingsville

Degrees included in Agreement:

- 1. Baccalaureate Degree
- 2. Reverse Transfer Associate Degree

Degree 1:

Baccalaureate Degree

GPA Requirements for Program:

Students who have completed the program map requirements with the minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 for entry into the intended field of study or minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 for the College of Engineering and any other admission requirements will be accepted into the program, subject to capacity availability.

Requirements to Apply:

- Meet all Texas A&M University <u>admission requirements</u>.
- Completion of a program map with assistance of a Texas A&M Kingsville Advisor.
- Completion of Texas A&M transfer process.

ACC Credit Hours Required Before Transferring:

60 semester credit hours recommended. When ACC program maps include greater than 60 credit hours the student is encouraged to earn the maximum allowable hours before transfer.

Note - Transferability of WECM Courses:

Workforce education courses (WECM) are not automatically accepted by Texas A&M – Kingsville. Decision to accept WECM courses with a substitution form is the decision of the corresponding department.

Note - Program Information:

- The maximum number of transfer credits that will be applied toward a Baccalaureate Degree varies by program.
- Completion of the ACC Core Curriculum will transfer as a block and will satisfy the Texas 42-hour core general education requirements at TAMUK.

Degree 2:

Reverse transfer Associate Degree

GPA Requirements for Program:

2.0 cumulative GPA on a 4.0 scale recommended.

Requirements to Apply:

- Meet ACC minimum resident credit requirement.
- Complete remaining credits for chosen program at an accredited college or university.
- Verify that credit was completed within three years from the date of last attendance at ACC.
- Meet all remaining conditions for graduation as published in the ACC catalog.

ACC Credit Hours Required Before Applying:

30 semester credit hours.
