

Setting up an Email Account in Yahoo

1. Find a computer or go to your computer at home.



2. Double click the Blue E

3. Type in <http://www.yahoo.com> in the address bar and hit the Enter key.

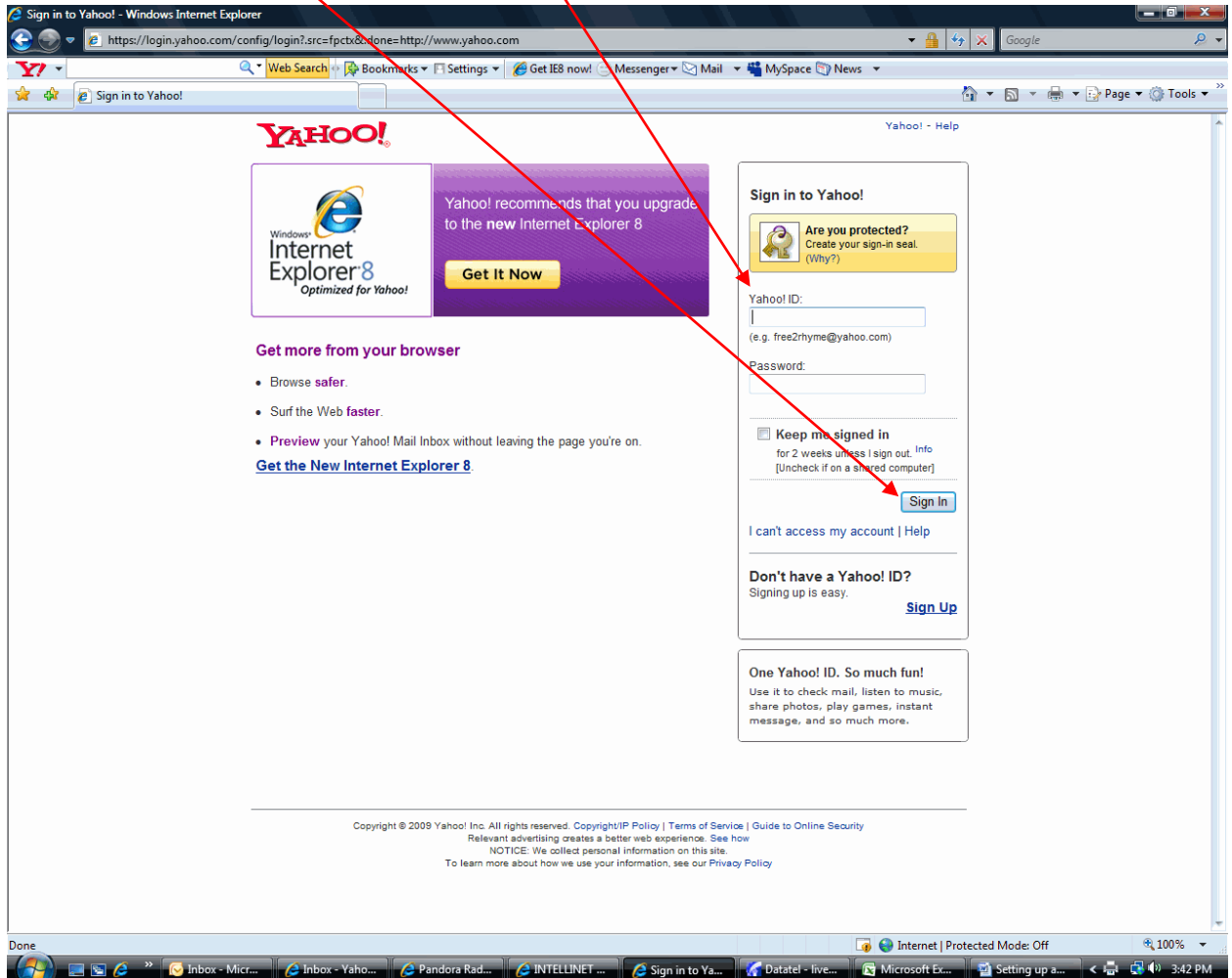
