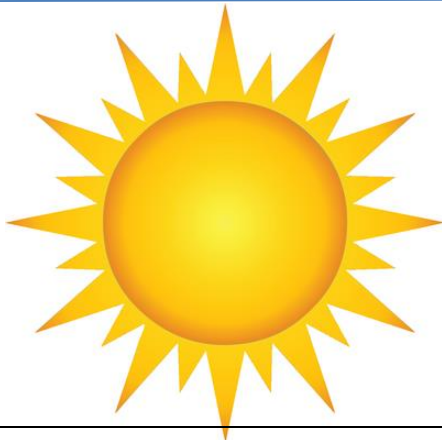

Summer II Registration: April 4th-July 5th

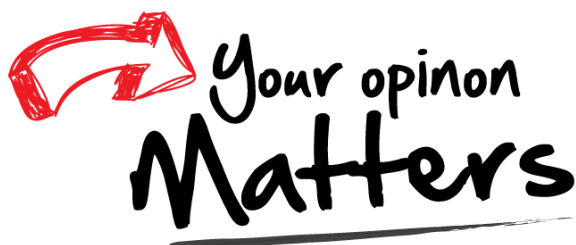

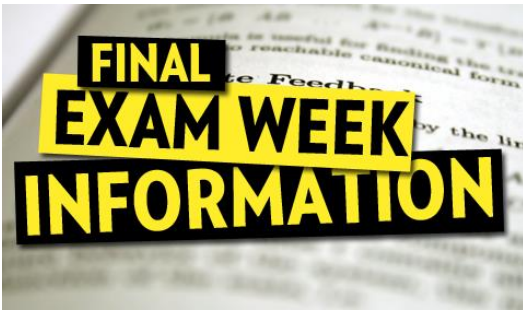


Spring 2016 Course Evaluations are now available!

ACC DUAL CREDIT FINAL EXAMS MAY 9TH-13TH



Final Exam week is May 9th-13th. By now your professor has shared with you when you will have your college final exam. IF you have an AP exam or other conflict with the date of your college exam, it is YOUR responsibility to inform your professor of the conflict. Your professor will determine if you can take your exam early or on an alternate date. Communication with your professor is KEY!

1. **Keep your energy levels high!**
2. **Follow the 50-10 rule.**
Study 50 minutes of every hour and leave the last 10 minutes of the hour to clear your mind.
3. **Organize a calendar.**
4. **Create study guides one week before the final.**
5. **Study in groups only if it benefits you.**
6. **Take your time.**

8. **Relax.**
9. **Do a practice quiz.**
10. **Exercise and eat healthy!**

LOGGING IN TO WebACCess:

WebAccess is a very important tool for students to do the following:

- ✓ Review final/end of the semester grades
- ✓ Review unofficial transcript
- ✓ See program evaluations
- ✓ Request official transcripts (\$5.00 each)
- ✓ Review registered class schedule for the semester
- ✓ Update email/address/phone number information
- ✓ Request Enrollment Verification, and more!!!!



WebACCess

If you have not setup your WebACCess Account or need help logging in, contact the ACC IT Help Desk at 281.756. 3544.

If you take a college class online or at ACC, it is your responsibility to submit a copy of your ACC transcript to your high school Registrar or high school Counselor to earn high school credit. Unofficial ACC transcripts can be printed from WebACCess.

Blackboard Support:
