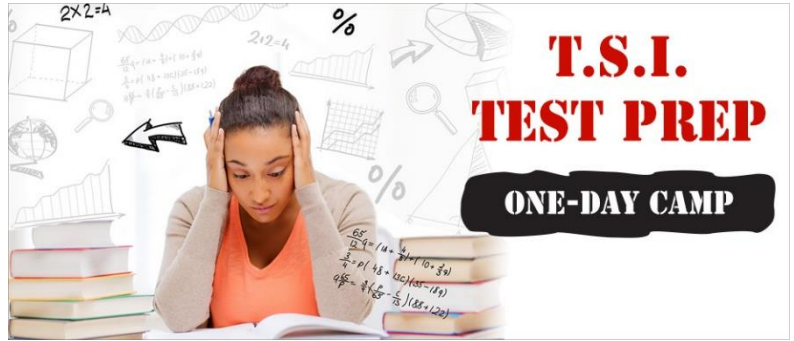

ACC Spring 2018 Withdrawal Deadline – April 18th



Withdrawing from your college class should be a last resort! Students that withdraw must do so with the high school counselor **and** the ACC Dual Credit Advisor. Withdrawing from a college course will result in a 'W' on the college transcript. While by law 'W's' will not count against you, for admission purposes it doesn't look good. Make sure you have done all that you can to try to be successful. If the course is just too difficult, visit with your high school counselor and ACC Advisor to discuss withdrawal options. **The ACC Withdrawal Deadline is April 18th.**
