It's time to select courses for next school year! Be sure to select the college courses needed for your desired academic path. Most college courses are identified by a **D** or **DC** next to the course's name and/or description.

***How do I know what college classes to take next?***

1. Print your ACC unofficial transcript through WebACCess.
2. Visit with your ACC Advisor to discuss your **pathway**. Your ACC Advisor will be able to assist you with course suggestions based on your goals.

***How do I register for my college courses?***

Your ACC Advisor will register you for any college courses you've selected and qualify for. You will receive more information about the college registration process in our up-coming newsletters.

***What if I plan to take summer courses?***

ACC summer registration begins April 3rd. The schedule should be available after spring break. Visit with your ACC Advisor to discuss summer courses and how they will impact your 2018-2019 schedule.

### Spring 2018 Withdrawal Deadline is April 18th

- Meet with your instructor before requesting a withdrawal.
- Make sure you have attended tutorials. ACC offers FREE tutorials [in person](#) and [online](#).
- Make sure you have submitted all assignments. Review your syllabus and always ask if there are any opportunities to make up work or to earn additional credit.
- If you have done all of the above and still desire to withdraw, visit both your ACC *and* High School Counselor. Students must visit with both. Failure to do so may result in a failing grade on your transcript.
