**ACC COLLEGE GRADES:**



You are enrolled in a college course this semester. Successful completion of this course will earn you college credit as well as high school credit.

Your first progress report will not have a college grade. You may see NG or INC. It is very normal not to have a graded college assignment within the first three weeks of class. Do not be alarmed.

College grades are recorded in [BlackBoard](#) (if applicable) and end of course grades are recorded in [WebACCESS](#). Students should maintain records of their grades according to the grading scale presented on the course syllabus.

**NOTES TO OUR CLASS OF 2018 SENIORS:**

1. If you are a candidate for the ACC Dual Degree in General Studies, please be sure to visit your ACC Advisor. Don't miss any deadlines and make sure you are on track to complete all coursework.
2. As you apply to various colleges, apply as an incoming Freshman! Yes, you have college credit, but unless you are specifically told by a university otherwise, you should apply as an incoming freshman.
3. Don't forget to send your ACC and High School transcripts to your college of choice. ACC transcripts are \$7.50 and can be ordered through WebACCESS.



**Academic Dishonesty** is any form of cheating and/or plagiarism which result in students giving or receiving unauthorized assistance in an academic exercise or receiving credit for work which is not their own. If you are caught cheating or plagiarizing, you will probably receive an F for the course!

Below are a few examples of plagiarism and cheating:

- Using the ideas and/or words of another person without giving that person the appropriate credit.
- Representing another person's scholarly work as your own (i.e. musical compositions, writings, etc).
- Submitting a paper purchased from a paper service, included but not limited to the internet.
- Using undocumented web sources(s)
- Allowing a student to copy from your paper
- Giving your homework, term paper, or other body of work to another student to plagiarize.



### Withdrawing/Dropping a College Course

The withdrawal deadline for the fall semester is November 13, 2017.

Students must:

1. Speak with your college instructor to discuss withdrawing.
2. Meet with your High School Counselor to secure placement in a high school course once withdrawn from the college course.
3. Visit with your ACC Advisor to process the withdrawal with the college.

**WARNING:** Withdrawing from a dual credit college course may affect high school graduation. A student who does not officially withdraw, will be considered enrolled which will result in receiving a failing grade for the course. That grade becomes part of the student's official college transcript.
