APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Gain Admission to Alvin Community College

Apply to Nursing

- Apply at the ADN web page: www.alvincollege.edu/ADN during the application period. Typically, March for Fall start and September for Spring start for 2-year programs and February for Summer start for the LVN-ADN Transition program. See [ADN web page](#) for exact dates.
- Submit official transcripts from ALL previously attended colleges to the ACC Registrar (electronic preferred).
- Have Advising Department to review out-of-state courses. This should be completed **90 days prior** to admission deadline. This is a mandatory requirement beginning Spring 2020. Foreign transcripts must be accompanied by an official evaluation from an [approved agency](#);
- Meet Texas Success Initiative (TSI) standards
- Attend an Applicant Meeting (meeting schedule is on the [ADN web page](#))
- Hepatitis-B: at the applicant meeting, submit proof of the first two Hep-B immunizations or the first "hepislav" immunization, or submit copy of Hep-B surface antibody titer report.
- Take the HESI-A2 exam within 5 years of nursing application deadline. Minimum scores: 78 on reading section, 78 for cumulative score. Order HESI transcript to be sent to Nursing@alvincollege.edu.
- Have grades of "C" or better, or be in-progress taking, these prerequisite courses:
 - ENGL 1301 – Composition I
 - PSYC 2301 – General Psychology
 - PSYC 2314 – Lifespan Growth & Development
 - BIOL 2401 – Anatomy & Physiology I
 - BIOL 2402 – Anatomy & Physiology II
 - BIOL 2420 – Microbiology for Non-Science Majors
- A 3-credit elective in Language, Philosophy & Culture or Creative Arts is required for graduation and may be completed either during the program or before enrolling in the program, but is not needed to apply (see [application instructions](#) for list of allowed electives)

What's Next?

Approximately six (6) weeks after the nursing application deadline, we will email you whether you are conditionally accepted, or on the alternate list, or neither of these.

If Accepted?

Nursing admission is conditional, based on completing the following:

- Attend an orientation meeting
- Pass a drug screen
- Pass two background checks: one done for the Texas Board of Nursing and another done by ViewPoint
- Submit copy of Social Security card if ViewPoint is unable to verify your social security number
- Submit copy of Physical Examination report
- Submit copies of Tests, Titters, Immunization series: Tuberculosis test, Hepatitis-B, MMR, adult Tdap, Varicella, and Seasonal Influenza
- Submit copy of Driver's License or another official picture ID
- Submit copy of current CPR card
- Before starting your second semester in the nursing program, submit proof of health insurance and copy of a Hepatitis-B titer report
