ABOUT THE SPEAKER

Dr. Alexander Marriott is an ACC Instructor of History, a Department Chair, and the Interim Dean of Arts and Sciences. Previously, he was an Assistant Professor of History at Wiley College. He did his undergraduate work in history at the University of Nevada-Las Vegas, and his graduate work in American intellectual and political history at Clark University.

Among other topics, Dr. Marriott will discuss his publications. His research specialization is intellectual history and political thought of the American framers. He recently published a chapter in a history book, James K. Polk and His Time (University of Tennessee Press), as well as a detective novel, The School of Homer (Vanguard Press). He is currently working on a follow-up detective novel as well as articles on American Revolutionary War constitutionalism and James Madison's handling of the War of 1812.

Dr. Marriott juggles a full family life, travels whenever possible, and is also learning modern Greek. He looks forward to sharing his experience and perspective with the ACC campus, especially with respect to pursuing professional and personal goals.
