John J. Murray Jr. graduated from Drake Law School in 2004, then served as a Captain in the Army JAG Corps. John also was selected to be one of two law instructors at the United States Army Military Police School.

After leaving the military, John spent the next eleven years in private practice (civil litigation and criminal law). Since 2020, he has directed the paralegal program and instructed law at ACC. He is currently the ACC Paralegal Program Director and law instructor. John is a bestselling and award-winning author whose books have been seen on CBS, NBC News and Fox. His latest textbook, an intro to law, is forthcoming. John also runs two national weekly Bible study groups and board-serves a nonprofit organization. The latter educates audiences across the nation on responding to sexually abused victims in a Biblical way.
