Jason Angell is the author of the book Running Towards Gunfire: Courage and Brotherhood in Ramadi. Running Towards Gunfire is a gritty, no-holds-barred, first-person account of the realities of modern urban combat, bringing the reader onto the streets of Ramadi and into the minds of combat Marines as they fight for each other and their brothers-in-arms during some of the most savage fighting of the Iraq War.

Jason is a former captain in the United States Marine Corps with over ten years of active service as both an enlisted and commissioned officer. During his career, Jason participated in three combat deployments to Iraq, including the initial 2003 invasion, going on to fight in the Rumaila oil fields, Baghdad, Ramadi, and Al Hit. He earned his bachelor's degree from California State University, Fullerton, in 2000, and a master's degree from the University of Houston in 2015. Jason lives with his wife and children on a farm in Texas.
