Maurice C. Cook is a distinguished figure in Texas law enforcement and military service. Currently serving as the Sheriff of Bastrop County, Texas, Cook is the proud former Chief of the Texas Rangers and a United States Air Force veteran who served in the Vietnam War.

Cook's notable Texas law enforcement career includes but is not limited to being a Highway Patrol officer, a Houston Intelligence Agent, working in the Motor Vehicle Theft Service, graduating the FBI National Academy, and, of course, being a Texas Ranger, where his leadership skills and commitment to justice led him to serve as their Chief until his retirement from the department in 1996. Cook also served at Alvin Community College as Department Chair for the Criminal Justice Department, and Director of the Police Academy. His debut memoir, *Unlikely Texas Ranger: You Be the Judge*, details the riveting points of his life and career.
