SQ3R – A Reading/Study Strategy

SQ3R Stands for Survey, Question, Read, Recall, Review

How to Survey

Look over the material Read the summary (if possible) Bring up background knowledge

Survey: Look over the material

Title

Preview or introduction Headings or subheadings Visuals: charts, maps, graphs Bold, italics

Summary Questions

How to Question

Turn headings into questions Ask WHAT, WHO, WHY, and HOW

How to Read Actively

Look for answers to questions

Talk

Write in margins

Highlight

Stand up

How to Recall

Say it

Write a summary

Write notes (in book or on paper)

Create 3x5 cards

Create a mind map or graphic

How to Review

Immediately after reading

Weekly

Before tests

Re-read highlights

Check over notes

Get the big picture Decide importance Know important points Connect known to unknown Prepare to read

Why Question?

Stay Focused Gives Purpose **Creates Interest**

Why Read?

Gain information Prepare for lecture Prepare for discussion Prepare for tests

Why Recall?

Retain information Check understanding Interact with the information
