Q+A: VIRTUAL AUDITIONS

In order to keep our patrons, cast and crew, and staff safe during our upcoming fall and holiday productions, ACC Theatre has begun the transition to virtual theatre. Read more on what to expect below.



What does virtual theatre mean?



Instead of having our audience inside our theatre space, ACC Theatre's fall and holiday productions will be live-streamed through the online platform Broadway on Demand (https://get.broadwayondemand.com/). The livestreams will be ticketed, and only available at set times (not on demand).



So the cast and crew will be physically sharing the same space?



There will be at least one in-person rehearsal at the end of the rehearsal process. As many rehearsals as possible will be conducted virtually, through a conferencing platform.



What COVID-19 precautions will be taken for in-person rehearsals?



First, all participants will need to pass the official ACC screening checkpoints to enter the ACC campus. This includes temperature screenings and a form certifying the individual's lack of COVID-19 symptoms.

Second, all participants are required to wear masks for all rehearsals.

Third, all social distancing protocols will be observed. Each person will have their own space to work within, including the actors. Camera angles and set design will be utilized so that actors remain at least six feet apart but will appear to be closer together. Other precautions are being tested for effectiveness. Access to some areas of the theatre and its facilities may be restricted or designated as 'staff only.'



What if someone wants to audition, but doesn't have access to the Internet or a device for conferencing?



This doesn't disqualify the individual from auditioning. They just need to be upfront about their situation so we can address it in the most effective way possible. There are several alternatives and solutions currently being tested and developed.

What about auditions and callbacks?



Auditions for *Antigone* will be held virtually – a recorded one-minute monologue and the completed audition form can be submitted during the August 18-25 audition window. Interested parties can contact boxoffice@alvincollege.edu to request the forms, instructions, and any other information they need. Information about auditions for the holiday show will be announced soon.

Callbacks will be held through virtual conferencing on August 26th at 7:00pm.
