



Steps 1 and 2 must be completed by Deadline June 1, 2024

STEP 1 Apply to Alvin Community College

- Start online at www.https://www.applytexas.org/
- Select Create Account and enter your profile information by clicking on "Start/Edit Profile"
- Very Important: be sure to enter your social security number if you have one
- Select "Start/Edit Applications" then "Start a New Application"
- Select Two-year Community/Junior College then Alvin Community College (Alvin) as the institution in the drop-down menu
- Select Dual Enrollment for your application type and semester (Fall but you can select Spring or Summer if Fall is not available)
- Select Alvin Community College again General Studies-Associate of Arts as your major
- You will answer Dual Credit questions and Questions specific to Alvin Community College
- You will be applying to the 16-week term
- When you have completed all steps, click submit and you will see confetti on your screen!
- Once application is submitted, you will receive an email with confirmation number from Apply Texas
- Within 2-3 days you will receive your acceptance email from ACC with your ACC ID number, ACC student email, and ACCess ID

STEP 2 Take TSI Exam or provide waiver or exemption
