MEDICAL CRISIS PROTOCOL

ON ACC CAMPUS

- Stay with the individual
- Contact ACC Campus Police, 281.756.3700, provide as much information as possible
- ACC Campus Police will call 911

OFF ACC CAMPUS

- Call 911, provide as much information as possible
- Contact ACC Campus Police, 281.756.3700 to report the incident, after the individual has received medical attention

CRISIS EXAMPLES

- Suicidal thoughts, intent, plan and/or risk of harm to self
- Homicidal thoughts, intent, plan and/or risk of harm to others
- Unable to care for oneself, such as not being able to eat or sleep for several days
- Perceptual disturbances, such as hearing or seeing things others do not hear or see

MENTAL HEALTH CRISIS PROTOCOL

On ACC Campus,

Fall/Spring 8:00am-5:00pm Monday-Friday

Summer 7:30am-5:00pm Monday-Thursday

- Stay with the student
- Walk student to the Welcome Center or contact Counseling Services, 281.756.3531 or via Teams
- If Counseling Services is unavailable, contact ACC Campus Police, 281.756.3700

Off ACC Campus,

After 5:00pm, on the weekend or off-campus

- Contact ACC Campus Police, 281.756.3700 (Available 24/7)
- Provide as much information as possible and request a welfare check
- Provide the student with the crisis numbers
- If in person, do not leave student alone
- Submit a counseling referral, counseling@alvincollege.edu

- Contact student's high school counselor*
- Stay with student until the high school counseling team arrives
- Provide student with the crisis numbers

*If they do not have a designated high school counselor, contact ACC Campus Police, 281.756.3700

- Contact ACC Campus Police, 281.756.3700
- Provide as much information as possible and request a welfare check
- Contact student's high school counselor to follow up

N AN EMERGENCY TAKE ACTION



HOLD! In your room or area. Clear the halls. **STUDENTS INSTRUCTORS AND STAFF**

Clear the hallways and remain in your area or room until the "All Clear" is announced

Do business as usual

Close and lock the door Account for students, visitors and others Do business as usual



SECURE! Get inside. Lock outside doors. **INSTRUCTORS AND STAFF STUDENTS**

Return to inside of building Do business as usual

Bring everyone indoors Lock outside doors Increase situational awareness Account for students, visitors and others Do business as usual



LOCKDOWN! Locks, lights, out of sight. **INSTRUCTORS AND STAFF STUDENTS**

Move away from sight Maintain silence Do not open the door Prepare to evade or defend Recover people from hallway if possible Close and lock the door Turn out the lights Move away from sight Maintain silence

Do not open the door Prepare to evade or defend



EVACUATE! (A location may be specified) **STUDENTS**

Leave stuff behind if required to If possible, bring your phone Follow instructions

INSTRUCTORS AND STAFF

Lead evacuation to specified location Account for students, visitors and others Notify if missing, extra or injured people



SHELTER! Hazard and safety strategy. **STUDENTS**

Use appropriate safety strategy

for the hazard Hazard Safety Strategy

Evacuate to shelter area Tornado

Seal the room Hazmat

Earthquake Drop, cover and hold Get to high ground Tsunami

INSTRUCTORS AND STAFF Lead safety strategy

Account for students, visitors and others Notify if missing, extra or injured people
