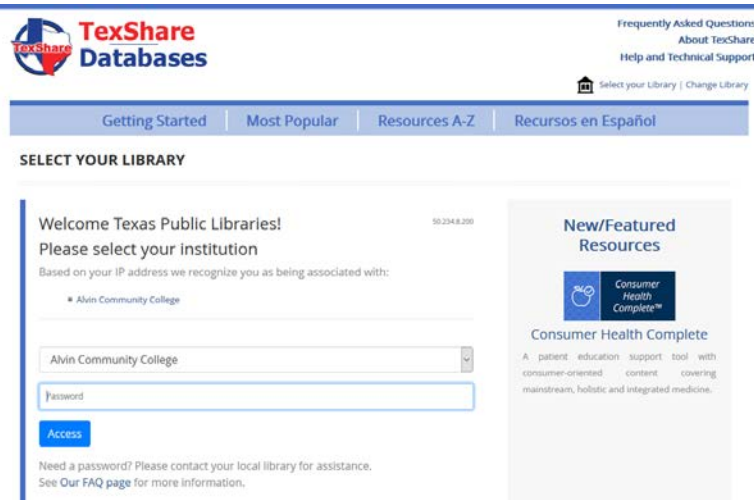
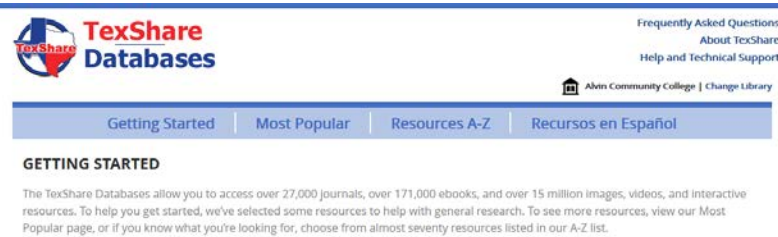


# EBSCO Databases Help Sheet

5. Scroll down and choose

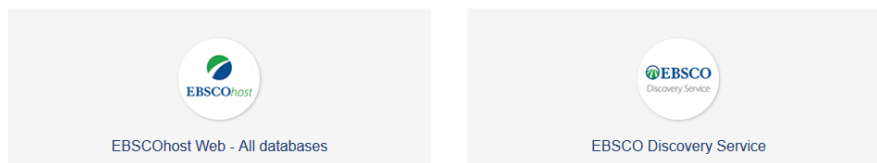

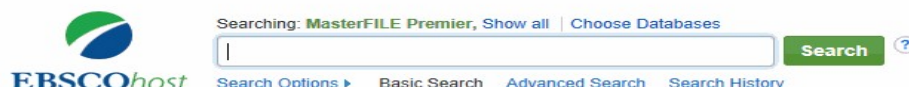
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7. Select All and click Continue
