Why Dual Credit?

- Save Time. Earn college and high school credit together, and accelerate your college degree completion time.
- **Fulfill Requirements.** Satisfy requirements for high school and college simultaneously.
- Transferability. Core classes will transfer with a grade of C or higher to any Texas Public College or University and may be accepted by out of state and private colleges.
- The College Experience. College courses are taught on your campus by ACC professors and/or College Certified High School Instructors.
- Free College Advising & Resources for Success. ACC Advisors are available to assist. Students also have access to the college Library, Learning Lab Tutorials, Career Exploration assistance and more.
- Save Money. Dual Credit College students pay reduced tuition and fees to participate in the program. Check with your ACC Advisor to determine the exact cost for your district.



Participation in the Dual Credit program means money saved. Dual Credit college courses taken on the high school campus cost less than they would at ACC and much less than at a university.

Cost based on a 3 hour college class. Cost subject to change. Courses offered and high school credits rewarded are also subject to change.

What is Dual Credit?

The ACC Dual Credit program provides an opportunity for eligible high school students, grades 9-12, to participate in college courses and receive both high school and college credit for the same course.

What is Dual Degree?

The Dual Degree agreement between the high schools and ACC offers qualified students the opportunity to earn a high school diploma and an Associate of Arts degree in General Studies at the same time.

Both programs are rigorous and will require extra time and dedication to study. These programs are not for every student, and successful candidates should make above average grades, be highly motivated, be able to manage time wisely, possess good study habits, be able to stick to a goal, and not be afraid to seek help!

What is Offered?

Alvin Community College offers high school students the opportunity to earn college credit while in high school. Students can take dual credit academic and technical courses.

Dual Credit Academic– These are transferrable core courses generally required for all 4 year bachelor degree programs.

Dual Credit Technical– These courses generally do not transfer to the 4 year university, but are instrumental in completing a technical degree at Alvin Community College, or completing a certificate before graduating from high school.

Both pathways lead to success and savings!
