Admissions:

In last semester of course work at Alvin Community College students must show evidence of a cumulative GPA in both general education prerequisite courses and nursing courses, each meeting a minimum of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.

All prerequisite courses must be completed with a grade of “C” or better prior to the beginning the program.

ADN graduates must meet all TTUHSC School of Nursing admission requirements, including general education.

ADN graduates must have passed the NCLEX and be in good standing with the Texas Board of Nursing
