Admissions:

Must be in good academic and behavioral standing.

Must complete the ACC-accredited AS in Computer Information Technology with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale for all college work attempted.

Must complete all lower-level required courses for the Computer Information Technology program with a grade of C or better and a minimum GPA of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale for all required courses.

Must meet admission standards and comply with admission procedures of UHCL.

UHCL may limit the Agreement of transfer credits accepted from an ACC student that exceed seventy-five (75) semester credit hours or that were accepted in transfer by ACC from a non-accredited foreign or non-regionally accredited institution.

All determinations that an ACC student has satisfied the pre-requisites for admission and the application of credit to a UHCL program of study shall be made at the absolute discretion of UHCL.
