

Health Science Reasoning Test (HSRT)

What is the HSRT?

The Health Science Reasoning Test (HSRT) is an exam that measures critical thinking and quantitative reasoning skills essential for success in health science education and practice. The test evaluates skills such as analysis, interpretation, inference, evaluation, explanation, inductive and deductive reasoning, and numeracy.

For applicants to the Respiratory Care Program at Alvin Community College, completion of the HSRT is a required step in the admission process

HSRT Testing Information

- **Format:** 35 multiple-choice questions
- **Time:** 50 minutes
- **Content:** General health science and clinical practice scenarios (no prior technical knowledge required)
- **Purpose:** To help assess readiness for success in a rigorous health sciences program

2. Schedule Your Test

- Testing is conducted in person at the ACC Testing Center.
- If you choose to test before the April 14th date, you will need to schedule with the testing center by calling 281-756-3526.
- If you schedule an appointment with the testing center, you **MUST** contact the program with the appointment information so the exam access can be sent to the testing center.



3. On Exam Day, Bring:

- A valid photo ID (ACC student ID is acceptable)
- Receipt of payment for the HSRT
- ACC POD login information

Scratch paper will be provided by the Testing Center

4. Important Notes

- The HSRT may only be taken once. Multiple attempts, even at another campus, will invalidate your application.
- Testing must be completed before the application deadline.
