Complete Placement <u>Testing</u> (Except for Level One Certificates)-Veterans exempt if honorably discharged (provide <u>Member 4- DD214</u> to Admissions). Must complete placement testing to take <u>in person</u> developmental classes. Developmental classes can not by hybrid or on line.
Apply for Financial Aid ( <u>FAFSA</u> )
Meet with <u>Pathways Advisor</u>
Submit <u>Veteran Certification Request</u> and ALL <u>Required Documents</u> to <u>Veteranservices@alvincollege.edu</u> (Veteran Certification Request form required each semester)
Register for classes and only take classes required for degree
Verify your enrollment with the VA (Post 9/11, DEA, Montgomery GI Bill)
Notify in ACC Veteran Services of <u>ALL</u> schedule changes.
Attend class: Failure to attend class will result in failing grades and will be reported to the VA
Maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress
